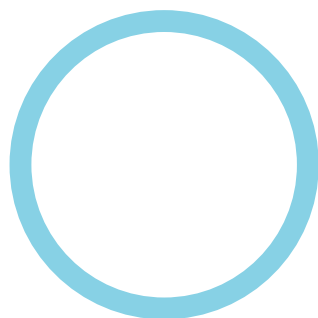
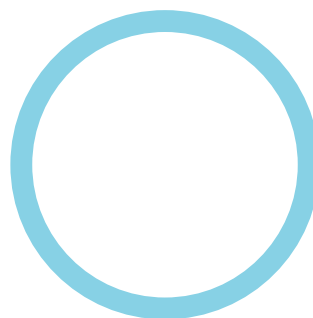


STATUE OF LIBERTY



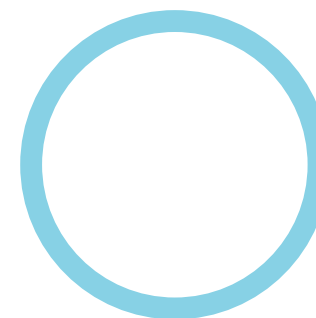
New York's Statue of Liberty is coated in 80 tonnes of copper. The green colour is caused by oxidation.

CONDUCTOR
